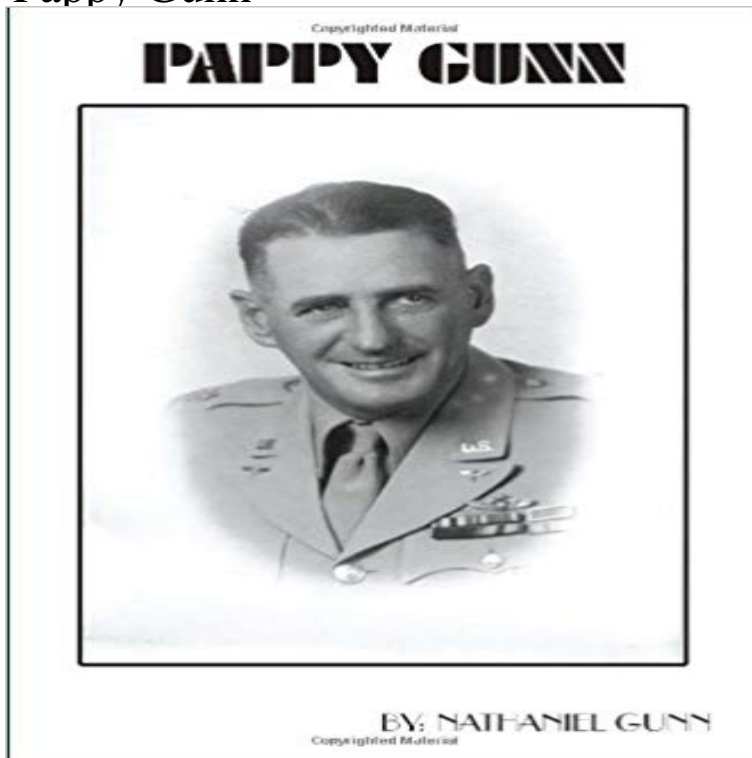


## Pappy Gunn
