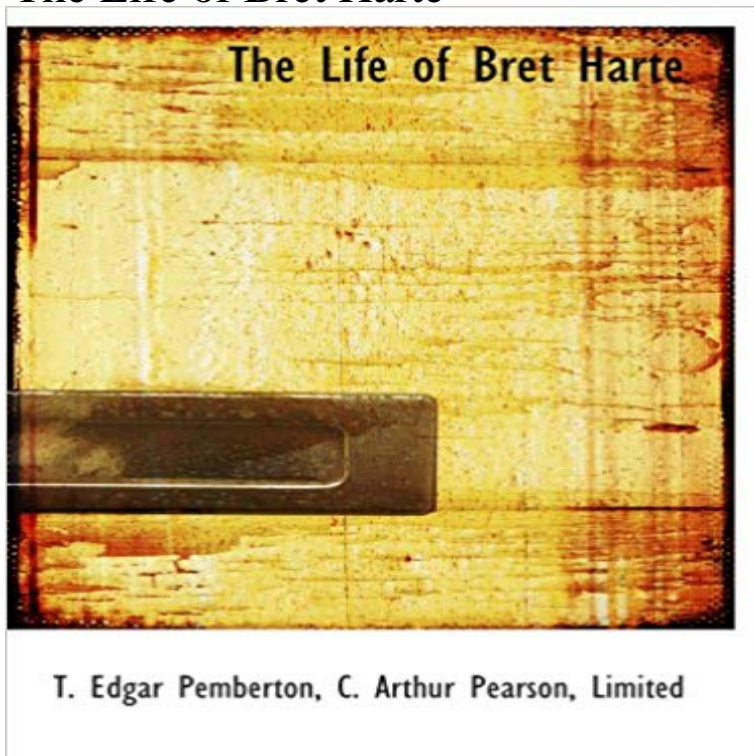


The Life of Bret Harte
