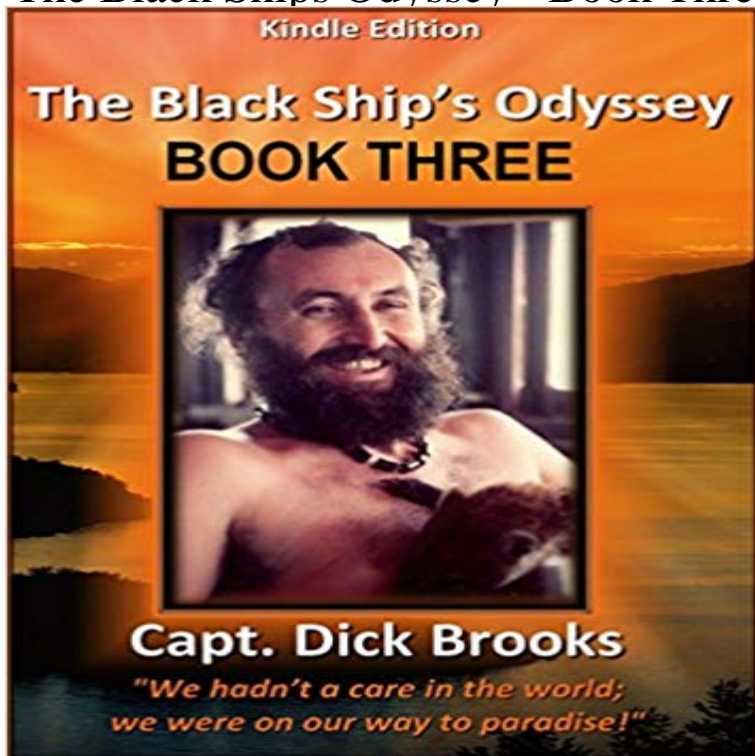


## The Black Ships Odyssey - Book Three
